
Dear Mr. Rolfe,

As a sophomore, Jonathan* struggled. His attendance and grades were abysmal. By the end of the school year, he had earned only 2 credits as a sophomore. But, something happened to change his course during the summer between his sophomore and junior year – Jonathan experienced a traumatic family tragedy that could have sent him even further on his downward spiral. Instead, he made a decision to change his life. During the first term of his junior year, Jonathan was invited by his high school administration to enroll in School of Life in order to work toward retrieving citizenship credit. School of Life could not have happened at a better time for Jonathan. The trainers and the positive curriculum served to solidify and support all that Jonathan was trying to do to turn his life around. At the end of that first term of school and as a graduate of School of Life, Jonathan had worked so hard to affect change that he earned all A's, and he then maintained that 4.0 GPA for the rest of the school year. Jonathan was invited to attend a district school board meeting, and was introduced to the board as a remarkable student. He was also asked to speak to the Term 4 School of Life students on their last day of class.
